Weekly's

For a no stress summer schedule • 5 lessons within 8 weeks

“Weekly’s” are a once a week painting date, that gives the participant an opportunity to paint over the summer with a schedule that has some wiggle room. Extra days and times have been built-in to cover vacations and varying time schedules. So if you need to break for a week or if you need to switch from morning to afternoon, no problem, you can fit your five lessons to meet the schedule that works best for you. And as always...drinks and snacks are provided.

- **Tuesdays • Acrylics for Beginners • Grades 1st thru 4th**

In 5 weeks your new artist will be introduced to gridding a canvas, laying in an under painting, blending colors and complete a painting ready to take home. All materials are provided. canvas boards, paints, brushes, and clean-up supplies. Limit: 4 per 1 1/2 hr. class. Tuition: \$125/\$20 per addition class

- **Tuesday's June 30 – August 18 • Available times: 10-11:30 a.m. or 3:30-5 p.m.**

- **Wednesdays • Oil Painting • Grades 4th thru 12th**

Limit: 4 per 2 hr. class. Pick 5 classes from the dates and times listed below to fit your summer schedule. Tuition: \$125/\$20 per additional class

- **Wednesday's July 1 – August 19 • Available times: 10-12 or 1-3 or 4-6 p.m.**

- **Evenings for Adults • Oil or Acrylics • Wednesday or Friday Evening**

A two hour lesson with a 3 hour time slot – so you are never running late. Only one class time available; 6-9 p.m. on two nights; Wednesday or Friday evenings. Limit: 4 per 2 hr. class. Tuition: \$125 / \$20 per additional class

- **Wednesday or Friday evening from July 1 – August 21 • One class time 6-9 p.m**

Black & White and Two Colors AND Currier Art Museum Field Trip

Art 101's third year with this session. Explore Black and White and learn to mix and apply shades of gray. (This is a wonderful skill to work on in painting and can be applied in other art mediums.)

We will learn to paint, mix color, stretch canvas and prepare a frame for a gallery wrap (*painted on sides so it hangs without a frame.*) Learn how to professionally fit a painting for hanging, draw and critique. At the end of the week your artist will bring home a wonderful painting ready to hang.

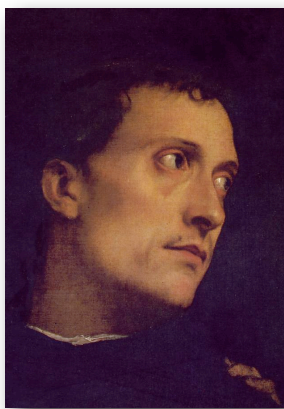

Time: 4-6 p.m. Choose the day of the week for the term.
Monday • Wednesday • Thursday • Friday • or Saturdays from 10-12 p.m.
ANNUAL TUITION: \$825 / Monthly Payments Available
Bi-Annual Payment paid in 2 installments;
• 1st payment - September \$450 due before first day of class
• 2nd payment - January \$375 due after holiday break

ART SUPPLIES: For your convenience, Art 101 will carry all materials needed and can be purchased through the studio. The payee will be billed via email when \$50 is reached or biannually. Or you can have a list to buy them on your own.

Make-Up Policy: All make-up lessons are on the 2nd Saturday of each month in the morning from 12-2pm. There are no discounts on tuition for missed classes. Any cancellations due to weather will be made up throughout the school year.

MONTHLY PAYMENTS: For all classes, parent will be billed via e-mail \$100 plus any supplies on the 15th and payable by the 30th of each month Sept thru May according to the class dates.

Student withdrawal : 30 day notice

Adult • Class available in 12 “drop-in” sessions. Sessions run in 15 week cycles. This works best with mom schedules... snow days... sick days... etc. Enjoy a 2 hr class with 3 hr window so you are never running late.
